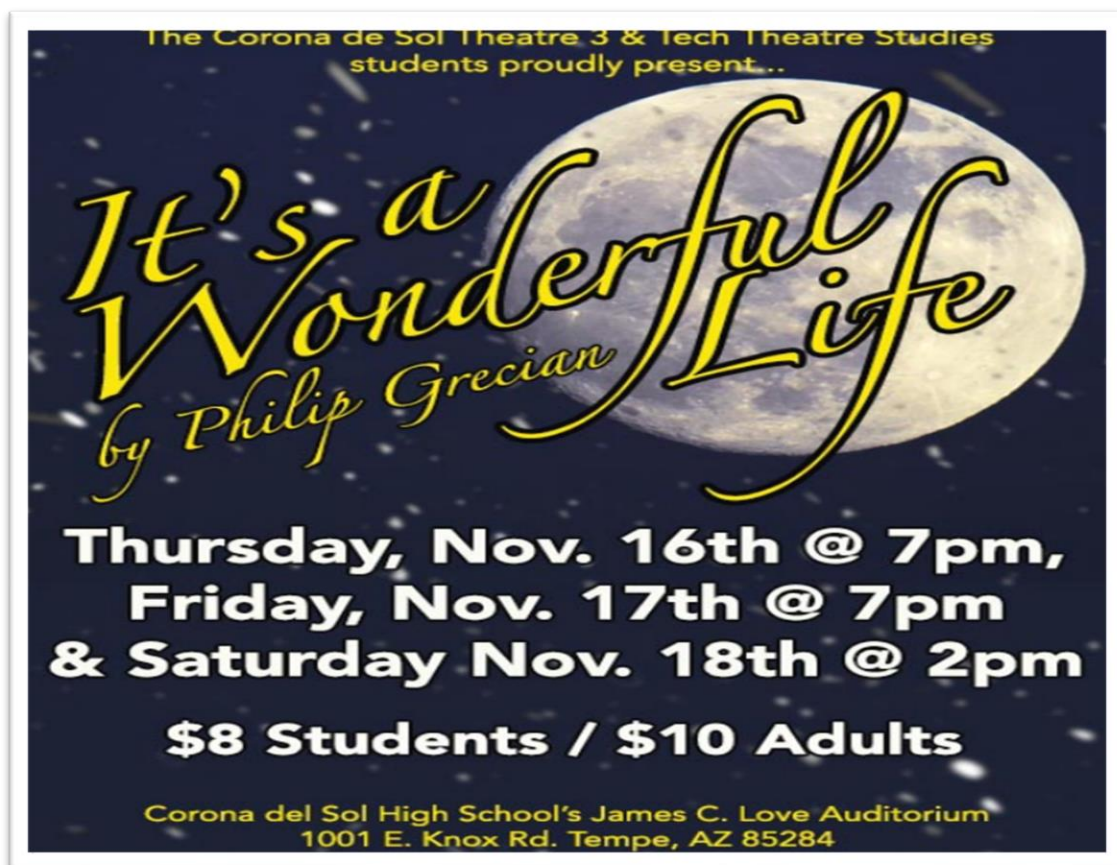

Electronic Use Policy: We have an electronics use policy that defines student expectations regarding appropriate technology use. Enrollment: For CdS enrollment and registration questions, or to update your email address, emergency contacts, etc., please send your request via email to cdsenrollment@tempeunion.org.

Item Drop Off: If you need to drop something off for your student, please do so during passing periods only. See the attached bell schedule to determine the appropriate time. Items will not be held in the front office.

Laptop Protection Plan: Any student that has been issued a school laptop is encouraged to sign up for the [Laptop Protection Plan](#). The plan may be purchased via the [CdS Online Payment Portal](#) or in person at the campus bookstore. LPP fees are good for the current school and must be purchased every new school year to remain valid.

Meals: To see if your student / family qualify for free or reduced meals, complete the online application available at [LINQ Connect](#). Please note the online application will process with 48 hours and the paper application may take up to ten days to process.

Students may purchase breakfast / lunch items with cash during their designated lunch hour. Additionally, if you would like to create a lunch account for your student, please visit [CdS Lunch Account](#). Students can prepay into their nutrition account by cash, check or online at <https://linqconnect.com/> For students to access funds from their lunch account, they will be required to show their student ID. Please review the attached documents for pricing, meal payment options and access to the free/reduced meal application. Corona del Sol is a closed campus. Students are not permitted to leave campus during their lunch hour.

- *Food delivery services such as Door Dash, Uber Eats, etc. are not permitted.*
- *Delivery drivers are not allowed on campus and will be turned away.*

Medication Procedures: All medication, whether over the counter or prescription, must be accompanied by an order from an appropriately licensed health care provider stating the name of the medicine, the dosage, and the time it is to be given. Medication must have an order on file to be administered. Any medication that needs to be administered during the school day must be provided to the school office in its original container, and all medication will be kept in a locked cabinet by the school nurse. Written permission from the custodial parent allowing the medication to be taken will also continue to be kept on file. Please review the [Medication Administration Consent Form](#) for giving prescription and non-prescription medications as school. For the safety and health of all our students, all medications, including Tylenol and Advil, must be kept in the school nurse's office. Students are not allowed to carry medications with them at school.

ParentVUE help: ParentVue is a useful tool to help parents be connected and support their child. ParentVue provides secure access to your child's:

- Schedule / Classroom information / Attendance
- Grades / Progress Reports / Test results
- Transcripts / Graduation status and more.

Make sure to include your student's name and ID number, as well as your email address. Student IDs:

- While on campus, students are expected to have the official 2023-24 Corona del Sol ID. Students will need a current ID to enter campus, will use the barcode associated with their student profile to gain access to the library, need the ID for laptop/book checkout, and for use in the bookstore and cafeteria.
- Students who do not have their 2023-2024 CdS ID can go to the library before school, during their lunch, or after school to have their ID made.

Corona del Sol is a closed campus for all students during lunch; there will not be any off-campus lunch IDs for the 2023-2024 school year.

Student Drop Off: Safety is our top priority and safety begins with a successful student drop off. As we partner together for a safe school year, please remind your child about the importance of following traffic safety rules. It is important we all drive with caution and allow extra time to accommodate for early morning traffic.

Knox Road Drop Off:

- Drop off is on the south curb only. There is a dedicated parking lane so students do not have to cross the street.
- No U-turns are allowed on Knox. Please drive around the block or use the cul-de-sac.
- Do not allow students to hop out of the car while you are in the middle of Knox Road.

- Drive cautiously on Knox. There is a crosswalk west of the auditorium and students are not always alert to all of the traffic.

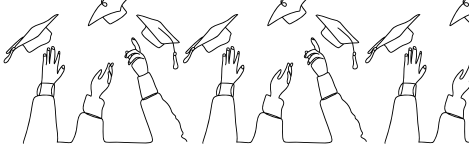
