## AP Tests

The AP deadline to order AP exams was November 1st. **If you order an exam as of November 2nd there is a \$40 late fee per an exam order.** These additional fees are set by College Board. There are no refunds for ordered exams after November 1st.

\*Microeconomics is an exception- this is a Spring semester class with a March 1st payment deadline.
