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About APPP

Program Objectives

- Helping APPP students graduate high school
- Improving birth outcomes by increasing pregnant teens access to prenatal care services
- Preparing teens to parent
- Decreasing teen and repeat pregnancies
- Improving opportunities for parenting teens to be financially independent and self-sufficient

APPP Services

A pregnant student in TUHSD has two educational options. She may choose to **stay on her home campus** and attend classes as part of the general student body. Case management, counseling and weekly support groups are provided by the APPP staff.

A more comprehensive setting is the Teenage Pregnancy Program (TAPP) **located at Compadre Academy (CA)** an open enrollment campus. Academic credit is earned through classes at CA and elective credit is earned through classes specifically designed for the pregnant and parenting teenager. Comprehensive case management service are offered to all students

- Pregnant teens
- Parenting teens
- Children of teen parents
- Teens at risk of pregnancy
