2023-2024 CORONA DEL SOL PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

This information provides details to register your car online and how to pay for a parking permit.

REGISTRATION FOR INCOMING SENIORS BEGINS MONDAY, MAY 22, 2023 AT 7AM REGISTRATION FOR INCOMING JUNIORS BEGINS WEDNESDAY, MAY 24, 2023 AT 7AM

- 1. REGISTER YOUR VEHICLE ONLINE: Please go to tempeunion.org/coronadelsol, ABOUT CDS, TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING, scroll down and register your information online. Fill out all fields and submit (no need to print). PARKING PERMITS WILL NOT BE ASSIGNED IF THE ONLINE REGISTRATION PORTION HAS NOT BEEN SUBMITTED.
- 2. Once you've registered online, bring this form, with signatures, to the Bookstore and pay the fee (\$125). You may also pay through the online <u>Bookstore Payment Portal</u>. Make sure to print a copy of the receipt. After payment, please bring this signature form, with receipt attached, to the Principal's Assistant in the front office. *Permits will be handed out during RESOURCE DISTRIBUTION in July.*

TUHSD PARKING POLICY

Student Automobile Use and Parking (Policy JLIE): The Superintendent shall establish procedures for registration, parking and use of motorized vehicles, and for searches for/seizures of illegal material contained therein. In the establishment of such procedures the Superintendent will be guided by the following:

- All students will register their vehicles
- Registration stickers must be displayed on all student vehicles. (Display on inside of driver's lower left front windshield)
- Vehicles may be towed away at student expense for failure to follow policy and procedures related to motorized vehicles

Automobile Searches:

The school retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of the exteriors of student automobiles on school property. The interiors of student vehicles may be inspected whenever a school authority has reason to believe that illegal or unauthorized materials may be contained inside. Such patrols and inspections may be may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant.

Seizure of Illegal Materials:

If a properly conducted search yields illegal or contraband materials, such findings shall be turned over to the proper legal authorities for ultimate disposition.

Providing parking for students at Corona del Sol is not a requirement, but a privilege.

Spaces are limited so please follow directions accordingly. Seniors have priority for parking spaces on a first come, first served basis. Any remaining spaces are then assigned to juniors on a first come, first served basis. The parking permit fee for the year is \$125.00. The cost pro rates by quarter. For second semester only, the price is \$62.50, however, 2nd semester passes may not be purchased until January 2024. There is a \$15.00 fee for alternate or duplicate vehicle stickers for any reason; this includes broken windshields, new cars or change of cars. Please go to the bookstore, pay the \$15 fee and bring the receipt to the Principal's Assistant. You must notify the office immediately or the new vehicle may be towed. Please remember to place the permit on lower left driver's side.

*All rules and regulations for CDS apply to the LDS church lot and to the carpool parking spaces. *

Students who forfeit their parking privileges or are withdrawn from school due to infractions of school rules, will <u>not</u> receive a refund. In addition, refunds will not be given if an application has been falsified.

If you have not purchased a parking permit and do not have an assigned parking space, your vehicle may be towed at the vehicle owner's expense. This will be strictly monitored. Reserved parking hours are from 6 am - 2:30 pm.

Loss of parking privileges may include, but are not limited to the following: Reckless driving, transporting alcohol, illegal substances, or dangerous weapons, failure to drive courteously, failure to provide adequate seating for passengers, failure to respond to school authorities, leaving campus without office approval or transporting students who are not permitted to leave campus. If you transport underclassmen off campus, you may forfeit your parking privileges.

<u>CARPOOL SPOTS</u>: We will be offering five carpool spaces. Carpools must have at least **two other students on a daily basis** for commuting to school. Please list all 3 student IDs on this signature form.

ONE SPACE - ONE STUDENT - ONE YEAR

Alternate vehicle information is only to be used when driving another car 2/3 times a week, with the purchase of an alternate sticker. Alternate parking stickers may be purchased for \$15. Alternate vehicles are family-owned vehicles only and must be registered. You may not share or buy spaces with friends. Violation of the parking rules may result in loss of parking permit/parking fees.

Park at your own risk! Corona del Sol High School, Tempe Union High School District and LDS not responsible for vehicle damage, theft thereof, loss of property or towing expenses.

By signing below, the student and parent/guardian agree to all rules and regulations set forth on this document. The parent / guardian signature also indicates the vehicle information submitted online is correct and vehicles are insured according to Arizona State Law (see below):

**Arizona requires that every motor vehicle operated on roadways be covered by one of the statutory forms of financial responsibility, more commonly called liability insurance, through a company that is authorized to do business in Arizona. This requirement also includes golf carts, motorcycles and mopeds.

Minimum levels of financial responsibility are:

- \$15,000 bodily-injury liability for one person and \$30,000 for two or more people.
- \$10,000 property-damage liability.
