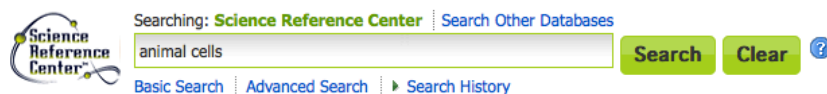


HOW TO ACCESS FULL-TEXT, PEER-REVIEWED SCIENCE ARTICLES FROM EBSCOHOST DATABASE

- Go to [Corona's library](#)
- Scroll down until you see EBSCOhost and click on it:



- If you are not on campus, use the following remote username and password for EBSCO: **cds** (username) **library** (password)
- Scroll down to **Science Reference Center**; click on it.
- Type in a subject (ex: **animal cells**); click SEARCH.
- On the left side of the page, check the “Full Text” and “Scholarly (Peer Reviewed) Journals” boxes. You can also narrow the “Publication Date” by moving the slide bar. Click “Update.”

- When you click on an article in EBSCO, you will often get just the abstract, so **LOOK** for a link that says, “HTML Full Text” or “PDF Full Text.” Once accessed, you can print, email, save, cite, export, link, or bookmark your article!
