It's that time of year again... SCHOOL PORTRAITS!

School portraits will take place on Tuesday, September 13 for Seniors, and Wednesday and Thursday, 14th and 15th all Freshman, Sophomores, Juniors in your English class. If you do not have an English class you will need to get your picture taken during Advisory period on Wednesday, at lunch, or before school starting at 7:45 am.

How do I dress?

If you are a Senior: This is a *formal* yearbook portrait and students should dress nicely. Review the [dress code requirements here](#).

If you are a Junior, Sophomore, or Freshman: This is a yearbook portrait that will be in the yearbook for years to come. Students should dress appropriately and follow the campus dress code. Review the [dress code requirements here](#).

Students not dressed appropriately may miss this opportunity to be in the 23-24 yearbook.

SENIOR ONLY FAQ:

Do I have to get my picture taken at school or can I still get it done at a Senior Portraits Session with Southwest Portraits?

You are welcome to call and schedule a portrait session, however, appointments are limited. You have until **SEPTEMBER 30TH** to have a Senior Session and still get your photo in the yearbook.

If I took a professional picture for my senior year can I submit that as my yearbook portrait?

No. We are striving for a uniformed look throughout the senior portraits section of the yearbook. If you took senior specific photos on your own you are encouraged to purchase a senior recognition ad to showcase these photos. 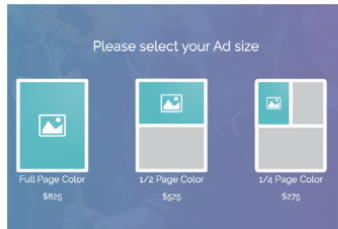

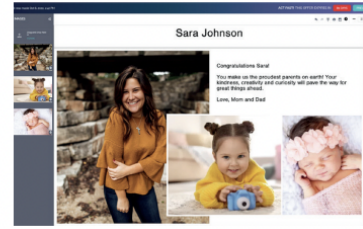
Step 1
