Registration

Registration Forms are available on the Tempe Union website or in the Guidance Department at all schools. All forms must be completed and signed by a parent/guardian and counselor. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis and determined by the order registration forms are submitted. Payment must accompany the registration form.

Registration Process:

Step 1: Complete the Registration Form

Step 2: Obtain a counselor's signature

Step 3: Make payment to bookstore

Step 4: Return signed form & receipt to the counselor

Tuition

\$175 per session (1/2 credit per course)

There is an additional materials fee of \$30 for Art & Design (ART100) per session.

* Reduced Lunch and Free Lunch Tuition must be approved by the site Administrator. Available only for current 2018–19 TUHSD students.

* Applications must be processed by May 17, 2019.

* A \$30.00 fee will be assessed to all refunds.

Transportation

Transportation is available from each of the Tempe Union High Schools to the Summer Education Academy. The fee is \$35 per session. To avoid traffic congestion, it is highly recommended to use the District Bus Transportation.

Attendance Policy

A student cannot be absent more than two (2) days per session.

Tardiness or early departures in excess of 15 minutes will constitute one (1) absence. On the third (3) absence, students will be withdrawn from their class.

Parking, Drop Off & Pick Up

Student drop-off/pick-up and student parking are located in the parking lot off of Knox Road.

- Enter from Knox Road.
- Follow signs to student drop-off
- Exit right from the driveway onto Knox Rd only



Please note: Traffic and parking are typically congested. Please allow time for drop off and pick up. Carpooling is highly recommended. Bus transportation from your home school is available for a small fee.
