CLASSROOM ASSISTANCE CONT. - TEACHER APPTS AND ACLAB

Appointments w/ Teacher: schedule for before or after school

OR

AcLab: Tuesday and Thursday, 11:09-11:45 (after p3)

- Reserved for struggling students and excessive absences
- All students on list go to Teacher's class who has called them out for assistance with that subject
- Otherwise, students remain with their homeroom teacher

CLASSROOM ASSISTANCE CONT. - ACLAB

AcLab expectations:

- During p3 announcements, sending teachers check the list
- 3rd-hour chime signals time to move to AcLab
- Only students with a “ticket” who are on AcLab list may be sent to requesting teacher’s class
- Remaining students must stay in class (restroom, drinks etc.) for the first 10 and last 10 minutes of Aclab

PLAGIARISM AND CHEATING

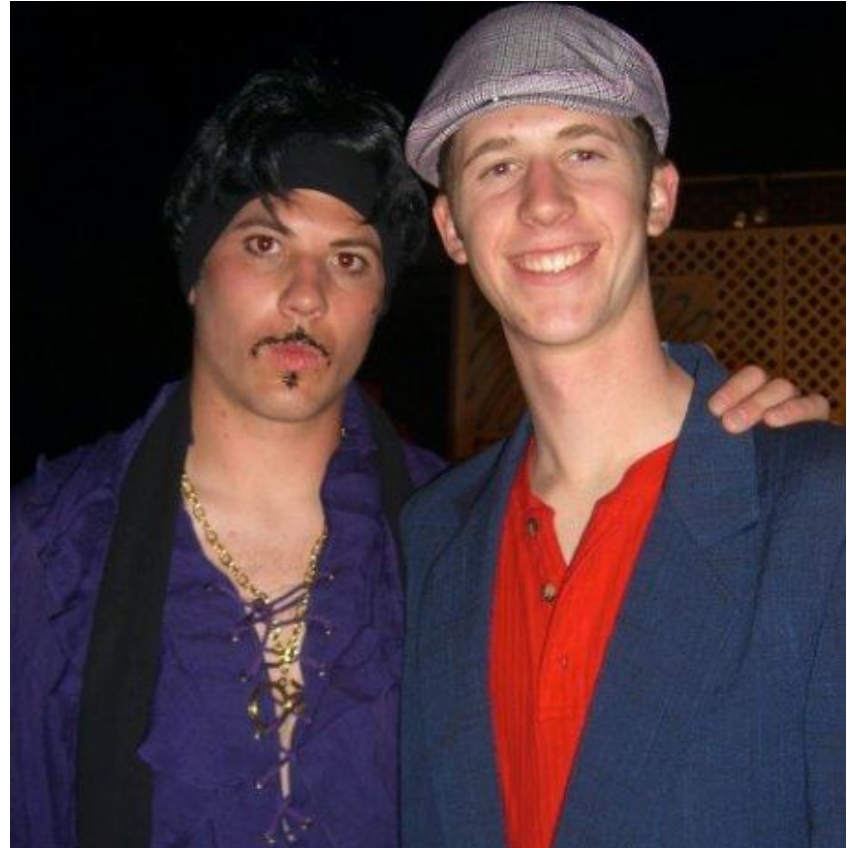
