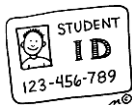

Aztec incentive rewards update: The Aztec Incentive Program Reward redemption process started Wednesday August 15, 2018; the redemption period will end on Friday, October 5, 2018. Redemption hours will be after school in the Library **only** as follows: Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 2:30 - 3:15pm, and Wednesdays from 1:30-2:30. Students will need a copy (not the original) of their qualifying scores as well as the requisite paperwork in order to redeem their reward; we require that students verify their scores in *SchoolCity* when they come to the library to redeem their reward. Rio Salado Dual Enrollment registration: Rio Salado will be on campus all day Tuesday, September 4th and Thursday, September 6th in the library to help students register for fall courses. Rio Salado will also be available in the guidance office every **Tuesday** during both lunches to assist in helping students get admitted, collecting required documentation for ID verification, Financial Responsibility and Consent Form and prerequisite overrides.

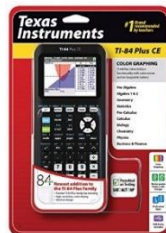
Student Drop off/pick up information: Parents, please remind your students to use the crosswalks at all times when crossing any street. This is for their safety and the safety of others. Please obey all the traffic signs around campus and remember there is no drop off or pickup on Knox Road in the West direction (and NO PARKING on the north side of the street). The area is clearly marked *No Parking*. U-turns on Knox Road are not permitted. We greatly appreciate your help as we try to keep everyone safe. Drop off/pick up of students is allowed in the Rural Lot and on the South curb of Knox Rd. **Drop off in the LDS church lot is no longer allowed.**

Reminder: The Corona del Sol front office does not hold items for students to pick up, **including lunch**. The one exception is your student's ID. Please arrange to meet your student **between classes** to give other items/lunch/money to them during passing periods. We will not call students out of class to pick up items. Below are our **typical** passing times. Early-release days (Weds) are slightly different – see attached bell schedule for exact passing times or feel free to call us at 480.752.8888 to find out the correct passing times.

Attendance Line: When your student is absent, please remember to call the Attendance office within **48 hours** of the absence. Always include your student's ID number, as occasionally we cannot understand the student's name in your message. When the ID number is included, we can quickly locate your student's information and properly excuse the absence.



Calculators: We would like to encourage you to get your math students a TI-84 Plus CE graphing calculator like the one pictured above. While CDS has a limited number of these calculators for use in both math and science classes, we will not be able to accommodate every student who does not have a calculator. The CDS Math department recommends purchasing a Texas Instruments 84 TI-84 Plus CE graphing calculator.
