Regular attendance at school is crucial to the academic success of our students. While we understand that some absences are unavoidable, it's important that being present at school and on-time for class remains a priority.

Starting this semester, we will be introducing a new discipline policy to help prevent students from being tardy to 1st period. Beginning on the 4th tardy of the semester, students will begin to receive progressive discipline for arriving late to class. Listed below are the discipline steps regarding being tardy:

4 TH Tardy	After School Detention 60 Minutes
5 th Tardy	After School Detention 60 Minutes
6 th Tardy	After School Detention 60 Minutes
7 th Tardy	Dropout Prevention Coordinator Meeting with student. Attendance agreement is signed.
8 th Tardy	Meeting with guidance counselor to discuss attendance.
9 th Tardy	2 Hour Saturday Supervision
10 th Tardy	4 Hour Saturday Supervision
11 th Tardy	Half-Day ISS & Parent Contact
12 th / 13 th Tardy	In School Suspension and return with parent
14 th Tardy	Out of School Suspension and return with parent
15 th Tardy	Meeting with administration for further discipline and / or possible removal from class.

If a student arrives late to school between 7:25-7:44 AM it is not necessary for parents to accompany them into the front office. Those students arriving during that time will receive a tardy for 1st period. However, if your student arrives to school after 7:45 AM a parent is required to excuse the absence from the class or classes that the student has missed. Students arriving after 7:45 AM without a parent present will receive an unexcused absence for 1st period. Please remember, a tardy and an absence are different attendance violations and as a result, follow different discipline guidelines.
