VOLUNTEER PROCESS – MOLLY SADLER	<p>Ms. Sadler reviewed the current process for volunteer application. Previously the process was thought to be so complicated that it discouraged people from volunteering. Some of the changes are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ References are no longer checked. The background check through the state is still being done.</li> <li>■ Parents are no longer required to wait to volunteer until the background check is complete.</li> <li>■</li> </ul> <p><u>Questions:</u> Should SBC members be required to complete the application? Are spouses of staff members required to complete the application?
